## SET THE SCENE

In 1959, The Junior Women's Club identified a community need for speech, language and physical therapy services after asking community members. In 1960, the Children's Rehabilitation Ranch was established and provided services in Lakeland to 60 children the first year.

In 1967, the name was changed to Central Florida Speech & Hearing Center (CFSHC) and audiology was added to their existing speech-language services. CFSHC was on their way to becoming the region's leading provider of compassionate care in the identification, diagnosis and treatment of articulation, speech, language, and fluency delays, stroke/head injury rehabilitation, hearing loss, middle ear conditions and tinnitus.

In 2012, CFSHC moved to a new building on Lakeland Highlands Road and expanded the speech, language and literacy services already offered, implemented new programs to reach more patients. The new facility and state of the art technology for hearing testing and hearing aid fittings allowed more people to receive services.

Central Florida Speech and Hearing Center stays true to their original roots and establishment. Like the Junior Women's Club did, the team continues to monitor the needs of the community and proactively seeks to provide those services. Today, CFSHC not only provides top notch speech, language and hearing care, but offers support, hope, and encouragement to those that are seeking ways to improve their communication and enrich their lives.

Last year, CFSHC began implementing several new programs, including a Communication Station mobile outreach unit, vestibular testing and treatment, a family resource center, a dedicated pediatric audiologist, a bilingual speech-language pathologist, adult specialized speech-language services, outreach education, and support groups.

For 64 years, Central Florida Speech and Hearing Center has provided a spark in the lives of many - committed to helping give adults and children a voice, the opportunity to hear their loved ones, and a path to lifelong success.







75% of children experience at least one ear infection by their third birthday



Falls are the leading cause of fatal and nonfatal injuries among older adults. The prevalence of falls in people over 65 is 30%.



Before children learn to read, they learn the sounds of language by listening and speaking. These skills provide the foundation for literacy.



Hearing loss is a critical public health issue affecting two-thirds of people over 70.




A student with a speech sound disorder is at risk for being bullied, struggling with friendships, and enjoying school less.



84.1% of people make a connection between stroke and brain injury and difficulties with communication.



Hearing loss can make it more difficult to interact with peers and can lead to decreased social engagement, depression, or bad moods.





A toddler with a speech sound disorder is at increased risk for later academic difficulties during the school years



Untreated hearing loss increases the risk for dementia. Hearing loss demands extra cognitive resources, which limits the cognitive resources that are available for memory and thinking. People with a *mild* hearing loss double their risk for dementia compared to those without hearing loss. Hearing aids have shown to slow cognitive decline in people at high risk.

She found CFSHC and was quickly seen; they knew her job was in jeopardy. She was fit with hearing aids the same day. Now, Didi has a new home, a stable job and reclaimed her confidence!

Zanna, a bright and bubbly girl, struggled with a history of ear infections and was referred for a hearing test after placement of tubes. Zanna was diagnosed with an asymmetric hearing loss. To show off her bubbly personality, she decided she wanted hearing aids with sparkly purple molds!

Zanna also began her speech/language journey at CFSHC. She started therapy, focusing on soft sounds she couldn't hear before. She excelled, graduated therapy and is now a thriving student!

### **FINDING A VOICE**

**Ayden,** a friendly boy with lots of energy, started babbling and vocalizing like most kids, but did not develop into using words. His behavior was a challenge as he couldn't convey his wants and needs.

Ayden's story continued at CFSHC and within six months, he showed play skills, followed directions, and copied words. Ayden soared in speech and language, culminating in his graduation from therapy after 7 years.

### **OUT OF ISOLATION**

**Armida,** a native of Puerto Rico, struggled to keep up with her friends and family members. She no longer went dancing and stopped spending time with friends. She knew she had a hearing loss but had limited resources.

Armida moved to Florida and met Dr. Perez, a bilingual audiologist at CFSHC. After an emotional appointment and new hearing aids, Armida got a sense of happiness back.
